Biography

Robert Shaw was born and raised in an unsaved home in the West Virginia hills. He received Jesus Christ as his personal Savior at the age of 19 while a student at Fairmont State College and shortly thereafter surrendered his life to the Lord. He married his wife, Karen, while earning a degree in Business Administration and she in Nursing. After earning his degree, he felt the Lord leading him to further his education at Bob Jones University. Where he earned a Master of Divinity Degree.

Ministry

Following graduation, he became a church planter in rural Ohio in the town of 178 people where he served for over 23 years. During that time he earned his Doctorate of Ministry degree. He had several interns that he mentored and had a heart to train them for ministry. After successfully leading the church through two building programs debt free, he felt God leading to help in the foundation of a small church centered bible college.

He served as a professor, dean of men and filled many other capacities while serving in this ministry for over 5 years.

God then clearly led him to take the senior pastor of Grace Baptist Church in Kettering, Ohio, where he served for over 10 years. He stepped down as senior pastor in 2015 and continues to serve at Grace as Pastor Emeritus while teaching in mission fields and filling pulpits as God opens doors. The ministry of Grace was turned over to a young man he had mentored for several years.

Presently, he is serving as interim pastor at Grace Baptist Church in Springfield, Ill. The desire of his heart is to encourage young men in ministry.

He has been in ministry for over 41 years and married to his college sweetheart for nearly 48 years. They are the proud parents of three grown children and grandparents to 15 amazing grandchildren.
